What will the Exhibition look like?

Your group's part of the Exhibition presentation will be made up of three components: written, visual and expressive.

The **written part** consisting of your individual Exhibition Journals, will include:

- Thoughts and ideas about many possible topics
- Thoughts and ideas about your group's chosen topic
- Descriptions of what happened at each mentor meeting
- Copies of the feedback given to your group from the mentor
- Goals/objectives for the upcoming week
- Records of all correspondence with individuals and organisations
- Notes taken during research
- Plans for ways to present your information
- Reflections
- Copies of all paperwork that you used during the Exhibition
- Copies of all assessment tools

The **visual part** of the Exhibition will be the display that your group creates of the process you experienced and the final products of your endeavours. This display will include:

- Your planner
- Inquiry points
- Key questions and their answers

The display may also include some of the following:

- Photographs
- Models
- Paintings, drawings or sculptures
- Science experiments
- Diagrams

The **expressive part** of the Exhibition will include some of the following:

- IT presentations
- Drama
- Dance
- Debating
- Video
- Oral presentation
